1953 - 1958 Studies at the "Gnessins" conservatory in Moscow musical theory and composition specialities

Obtains the title (degree certificate) of teacher and composer under the direction of the master Mr. Dimitri Shostakovich. Post degree: Composition studies at the "Gnessins" Musical Academy.

In the USSR was exposed to constant prosecution from state security service (KGB), including two years of imprisonment as the political dissident.

Author's comment

The present work "Prelude and fugue" is a cycle of two pieces for saxophones quartet.

Prelude and Fugue ("double" fugue with two subjects) are compound in serial system dodecafonica atonal with all the polyphonic rules such as investments, step of reverse, reverse in investment, double counterpoint vertical mobil and horisontal, step in increase and in decrease (in coda stretto) etc.

Nevertheless, the general form of the (architectural) work is functional sense, what it gives to the musician dynamics of the development and an esthetic value respectively.

La presente obra "Preludio y fuga" es un ciclo de dos piezas para cuarteto de saxofones.

Preludio y Fuga (fuga "doble" con dos sujetos) estan compuesto en sistema serial dodecafónica atonal con todas las reglas polifónicas tal como inversiones, paso de reverso, reverso en inversión, contrapunto doble móvil vertical y horizontal, paso en aumentación y en disminución (en coda stretto) etc.

Sin embargo, la forma general de la obra (arquitectónica) se mantiene un claro sentido funcional, lo que le da a la música una dinámica del desarrollo y un valor estético respectivamente.
